**Why take this course?** Who is it for?

This course is for any student who is interested in the dance and has some background in at least one style of dance. This course is a perfect platform for students who want to progress into the performing arts industry.

**What does this course involve?**

Performing dance. You will have to create three dance routines based around different styles of dance, these will then be performed to an audience.

Working in the Performing Arts Industry. You will investigate the role of a choreographer and a dancer. This unit will involve hoping out to visit dance organisation's and working with professional dancers and choreographers.
