**What is it worth?** BTEC Level 2 (2 GCSE equivalent)

**Why take this course? Who is it for?**

For students who enjoy performing and want to develop general theatre skills such as acting, singing and dancing.

**What does this course involve?**

Working cooperatively with classmates to rehearse and perform using given stimuli. You will develop acting skills through workshops and looking at plays, with opportunities to write your own scripts. You will develop singing and dancing skills, combining this with acting throughout a 'musical theatre' module. There will be opportunities to become involved in the 'backstage' aspects of performance, designing props, costume, sound and lighting also.
